NARI of Madison Remodeling Companies Receive Top National Awards
The National Association of the Remodeling Industry (NARI)
Names 36 National CotY™ Winners

[Madison, WI, May 2016]— The National Association of the Remodeling Industry (NARI) announced the National CotY (Contractor of the Year)™ Winners in the 2016 competition, of which two companies are members of NARI of Madison.

Contractors from seven regions around the country vie for CotY Awards on an annual basis. Earlier this year, NARI named 158 Regional CotY™ winners with 22 team members who advanced as finalists to the national level. NARI announced a National winner in each of the 36 categories at its Evening of ExcellenceSM reception, held recently in Austin, TX. The competition received 405 entries, which totaled more than \$100.1 million worth of remodeling projects.

Time 2 Remodel LLC with team members Gerhards The Kitchen and Bath Store and **Statz and Sons LLC**, Madison, WI, won a 2016 Region 3 North Central CotY & NATIONAL CotY, Basement Under \$50,000.

TZ of Madison, Inc. with team member Curran Cabinetry & Design LLC, Madison, WI, won a 2016 Region 3 North Central CotY Award & NATIONAL CotY Award, Residential Interior Under \$75,000

All projects submitted for judging were an improvement or an addition to an existing structure, with the exception of the Residential Detached Structure category. New construction projects were not eligible.

To be considered for a CotY Award, a company must be a NARI member in good standing.
